Gaps at a personal level ...


- Disconnects expectations and reality, intention and action, ideas and down to the earth …

Networking: with TUMJA scholars and alumni/ae from





You can expect...


- Trainings, workshops, cultural events

Application Process

Interested? Here's how to apply!



*Required documents


- Letter of Motivation (anonymized)
- CV (anonymized, tabular)
- Grade report
- essay OR video on this year's call

Required for initiative applicants, optional for everyone else:

Letter of Recommendation

- ** The second stage of assessment consists of:
- personal interview with tutors and mentors
- exchange your ideas for this year's call with other applicants
- group task

Be present on one of two days! (more information will follow by email!)

Will the Slides be uploaded?

Yes, you will get the slides afterwards (via email as well as on the website)



Can I go abroad?

Yes, you can go abroad during your time at TUM: Junge Akademie. However, note that you get most out of TUM: Junge Akademie when you are at least present during the Seminar Weekends.



Am I allowed to use AI to write the motivational letter / essay or create the video?

Of course you can use AI, however, please make sure to mark the sections where you used AI (and write the prompt you used as a footnote...)



Do I have to attend both Selection Days?

No, you only need to attend one Selection Day (either Friday or Saturday). You will get more information in September whether you have been selected for the Selection Days.



Can I apply when I finish my Bachelor's or Master's during that time?

Yes, you can apply – the most important part is that you're enrolled at TUM until the application deadline (August 31st).




