For many of them, Munich became their new home. With 'Buddies for Refugees,' TUM quickly launched a three-year program that provided each of the more than 640 guest students with one or, in some cases, several mentors as 'buddies.' Many of the guest students studied, some earned doctorates, and found their future here, and contribute today with an extensive range of expertise to our society's value creation. Initiated, structured, and organized by TUM: Junge Akademie, equipped with resources by a wonderful donor and bringing together the expertise and experience available at TUM, over 850 TUM members – students, colleagues from administration and science – contributed with enormous voluntary commitment. Cosmopolitanism, empathy, and respect were and remain cornerstones of our actions.

Now, ten years after that experience, our entire world is in a state of enormous flux. It seems that new ways of discourse must be found that are objective, intellectually sound, communicate well, aware of biases, and committed to the

truth. Where are the obstacles, what is not working? The current observations and the questions derived from them were undoubtedly one of the reasons why our scholarship holders for the new year, #class26, which starts in November, came up with the call 'Mind the Gap.' We are excited to see what topics the new scholarship holders in this class will develop over the next 20 months.

I hope you all enjoy reading our newsletter and find interesting and entertaining insights into the current cohort and the numerous activities organized by the TUMJA office, our scholarship holders, and alums.

I wish all students and colleagues a thriving and lively start to the new winter semester 25/26.


