*Required documents


- Letter of Motivation (anonymized)
- CV (anonymized, tabular)
- Grade report
- essay **OR** video on this year's call

Required for initiative applicants, optional for everyone else:

Letter of Recommendation

- ** The second stage of assessment consists of:
- **personal interview** with tutors and mentors
- exchange your ideas for this year's call with other applicants
- group task
